While some parts of kerala relish the dish, half of kerala do not consume kappa as often. Mashed Steamed Tapioca dishes are common in most parts of kerala and there are a range of recipes available which is quite good if you have the palate for it.

The output of Tapioca cultivation was expected in month of June 2023, which may approximate to 250 to 300 kgs, @ Rs 30 per kg in open market.
