One of the hallmark events orchestrated by the IQAC was the annual Academic Planning Session held prior to the commencement of each academic year. During this session, the IQAC team collaborated with stakeholders to strategize and implement new initiatives geared towards academic development and progression. Moreover, the IQAC diligently collected academic action plans from various departments, catalyzing the organization of departmental activities in alignment with overarching institutional goals.

Furthermore, the IQAC played a pivotal role in the publication of the college handbook and calendar, incorporating a tentative schedule for activities and internal examinations. Throughout the academic year 2022-23, the IQAC spearheaded numerous quality initiatives that left a profound impact on the institution's teaching, learning, and co-curricular landscape. The following initiatives were carried out by IQAC in the academic year 2022-23:

IQAC functions to cater to the needs of the students in their academics. With this intention, it seeks to involve in fruitful collaborations with external sources of knowledge for the purpose of project works and the internships of the student community. The institution signed an MoU with CIPET - Kochi for the benefit of students, which provided opportunities of fruitful collaborative research ventures. Collaboration with CIPET fosters connections with the plastics engineering and technology industry, providing opportunities for internships, industrial visits, and collaborative research projects. Students benefit from hands-on training and exposure to cutting-edge technologies in plastics engineering, enhancing their practical skills and employability in the industry.

IQAC and P.G Department of Commerce in collaboration with Youth Employability Skill Training Co-operative Educational Society Limited is conducting an add-on course on P.G Diploma in Accounting and Taxation. The course have been sanctioned from Youth

Employability Skill Training Co-operative Educational Society Limited under 'National Youth Programme' scheme registered under Central Co-operative Registrar, Government of India. Duration of the course is 1 year and 9 students of final P.G has registered for the same. The course includes three major papers namely Basic Accounting, Income Tax Law & Practice and Business Law which comprises of Contract Act, Special Contract Act, Sale of Goods Act and Cyber Law. Internal and external subject exports were arranged for undertaking each papers. Basic Accounting were handled by Ms. Anju T.A, Income Tax by Dr. Titto Varghese and Law papers were engaged by Adv. Reni James and Adv. Mary Rinju. Marklist and Course certificates were issued from the respective authorities.

The Entrepreneurship Development Club of the College was registered with Directorate of Industries and Commerce under the Entrepreneurship Development club programme of the Development of Industries and Commerce. This provides access to industry-relevant resources, fosters partnerships with local businesses, enhances opportunities for internships and placements, and facilitates collaboration on research and development projects, thereby enriching the educational experience and improving employability prospects for students.

Placement Cell has been strengthened and Student Orientation for Placements been initiated by Career and Placement cell of the College. This enhanced employability as the students receive guidance and support in developing essential skills and qualities sought by employers, improving their chances of securing employment. Students have the chance to network with industry professionals, potentially leading to internships, mentorships, and job offers. Preparation and guidance provided during orientation sessions can boost students' confidence levels, making them more effective in interviews and other recruitment processes.

In collaboration with the Ministry of Education (MoE), the Government of India, St. Xavier's College Vaikom inaugurated the Ministry of Education's Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) in November 2021. The primary objective is to stimulate, motivate, and cultivate the creative potential of young students by providing them with resources to explore novel concepts and cultivate an environment conducive to innovation. We are pleased to announce that our college has been honoured with a 1-star rating for our exemplary activities during the 2022-23 academic year, signifying our commitment to fostering innovation as a primary mode of operation.

St. Xavier's College Library 'LibXav' and IQAC in association with 5 other college Libraries and SanBella Edutech, Kottayam celebrated National Reading Week 2022 by conducting an Online Author Talk Series from 19 to 25th of June 2022. "Reading and Creative Expression" focused on how reading influences various art forms. "Varied Views on Reading" exposed participants to diverse perspectives on the value and purpose of reading.
